Oak Class have been learning to write non-chronological reports in English. They wrote reports about a sport that they knew well. This helped them when they started their new science topic on plants and growing as they reported on fair tests.



They have a test to see whether leaves make a difference to the way a plant grows with two tomato plants. They also have a test being run by each table, to investigate whether the amount of water a plant receives directly affects the amount of growth. They are using beans for this test. They are using lots of observational skills as well as measuring heights and amounts of water.



The class have continued the story from Easter and are learning a new topic about Pentecost and the birth of the early Christian church.

In PE Oak class continue to hone their cricketing skills for the tournament next week. Some year three children will be representing the school at Quad Kids and athletics competitions.
