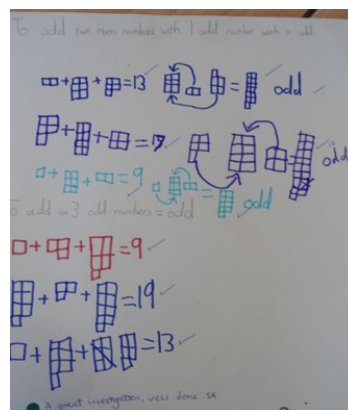
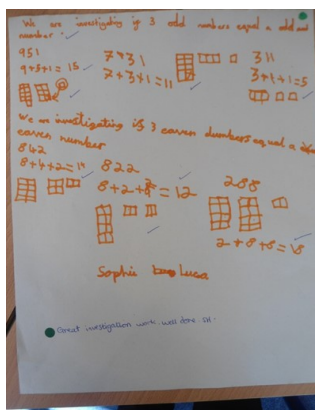

They have used clay to form head pieces for Canopic jars which were used to store different organs for the afterlife, something that the ancient Egyptians believed in. They used acrylic paints and gold pens to decorate and we glued them. The display is in our reception area now and they look fantastic. Well done!
