**T**his week in maths Willow Class have been learning about 3D shapes. Year 1 children can name a variety of shapes and count the number of faces and year 2s are also able to count the edges and vertices. Here they are making cubes, cuboids, pyramids and prisms out of Polydron. Some children challenged themselves to make an octagonal prism!



In our topic lessons we have been learning about the remarkable life of Mary Seacole and this week we combined this with an art lesson about hot and cold colours. We decorated one side of an outline of Mrs Seacole with hot colours and the other with cold.
