

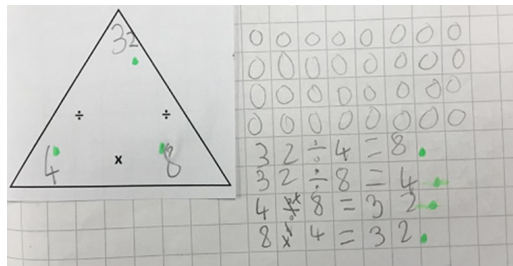

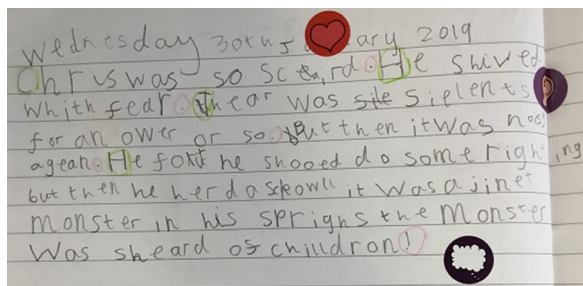
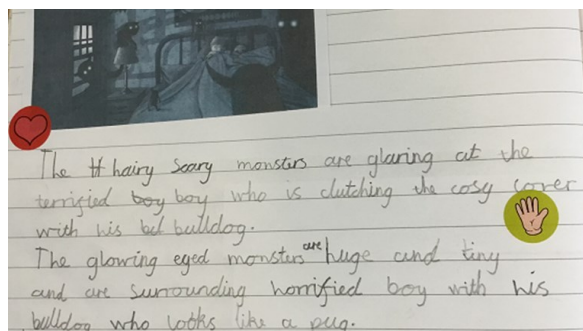

Year 1 have been learning how to make equal groups of objects and how to write the corresponding multiplication sentence. Year 2 have been drawing arrays and using fact family triangles to work out different number sentences.
