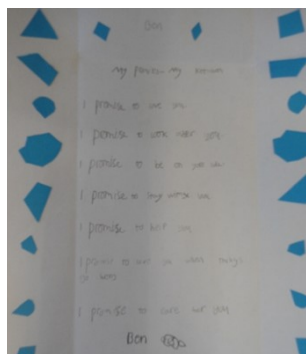
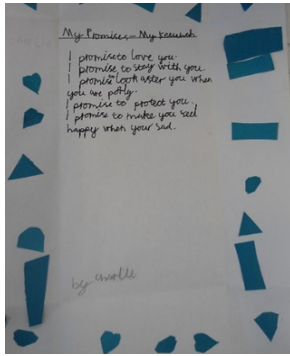
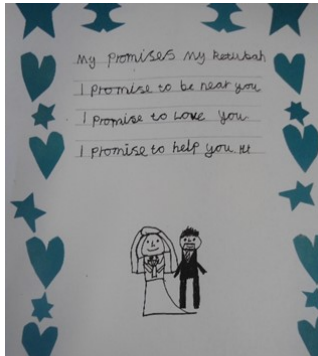

Oak Class have continued learning about the Second World War. Last week we spent a day using strengthening and measuring skills to make our own Anderson shelters. They designed their ideas in their sketch books having tested various materials for strength and flexibility. They had to make sure they included a door with a hinge connection, but many went much further and designed beds, tables and chair models to furnish the shelters. These are a few examples of the very high standards of finish they achieved. Everybody was very focussed and worked extremely hard.



In RE the class have been learning about life events and how they are celebrated in different religions. They looked at Jewish wedding traditions and the promises made. These are written in a document called a 'Ketubah'. The children enjoyed designing and writing promises of their own. They look very special and have some lovely promises.
